The Murdoch University Preparation Course (MUPC) prepares students for successful transition to degree-level study, providing a pathway to the first year of study of a bachelor degree at Murdoch University. Students can choose a program and intake according to their individual needs, academic advancement and unique career aspirations.

WHY STUDY A MURDOCH UNIVERSITY PREPARATION COURSE?

- Successful completion of the Murdoch University Preparation Course will provide students with direct entry into first year of their chosen Bachelor degree at Murdoch University.
- Students receive individual guidance and support to achieve their personal and academic goals.
- There are three course programs to suit individual requirement and efficiency. Experience life on campus while studying on Murdoch University's South Street campus.
- Articulation available to all undergraduate degrees at Murdoch University, with the exception of a Bachelor of Veterinary Science, which can be accessed through a Bachelor of Animal Science.
- Options are available to fast track the MUPC and complete it in one trimester or take more time and complete over two or three trimesters.
- Flexibility to start at any one of the three different intake dates every year.



PROGRAM OPTIONS

Murdoch Institute of Technology offers three Murdoch University Preparation Course options. The appropriate program for each student will depend on their academic qualifications, English proficiency and preferred Bachelor's degree at Murdoch University.

MURDOCH UNIVERSITY PREPARATION COURSE 6 (MUPC 6)

The MUPC 6 program includes six units, which may be completed over two or three trimesters. This course is for students who have successfully completed year 11 or the international equivalent and meet the necessary English entry requirements.

MURDOCH UNIVERSITY PREPARATION COURSE 4 (MUPC 4)

The MUPC 4 program is comprised of four units, which may be completed over two trimesters. It is for students who have finished year 12, with no ATAR subjects.

MURDOCH UNIVERSITY PREPARATION COURSE 3 (MUPC 3)

The MUPC 3 program is an accelerated course made up of three units, which may be completed over one trimester. It is for students who have successfully completed year 12 or the international equivalent and meet the necessary English entry requirements.
