

UNDER 18s STUDENT WELFARE & ACCOMMODATION

WHO SHOULD COMPLETE THIS FORM?

You should use this form if you are planning for your child to study at MIT while they are still under the age of 18. Please complete this form carefully as the Department of Home Affairs must be satisfied that appropriate welfare arrangements are in place for under 18 students before a visa is granted. MIT in some instances will be required to issue a Confirmation of Appropriate Accommodation and Welfare (CAAW) letter. Please read the [MIT Student Welfare and Accommodation \(U18\) Policy](#) before completing this form.

International students under 18 years of age must enter into one of the four care options listed below:

Please specify who will take up welfare arrangements while your child is studying in Australia (tick one option only):

OPTION A

Student is intending to reside with relative or a custodian, subject to approval by the Department of Home Affairs. MIT is not required to issue CAAW in this instance. **(Please complete Sections 1, 2, 3 & 7)**

OR

OPTION B

Student is intending to reside with a homestay arranged by AHN. MIT will issue the CAAW in this instance. **(Please complete Sections 1, 2, 4 & 7)**

OR

OPTION C

Student is intending to reside at Murdoch University Village – this option is only available for students above 17.5 years old. MIT will issue the CAAW in this instance. **(Please complete Sections 1, 2, 5 & 7)**

OR

OPTION D

Student is intending to reside with a local individual (caregiver) nominated by the parents. This arrangement will need to be approved by MIT, and MIT will issue the CAAW in this instance if the living arrangement is approved. **(Please complete Sections 1, 2, 6 & 7)**

DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST:

- Photocopy of both parents' ID, which includes a photo and signature such as a passport or driver's licence (all applicants)
- OPTION B ONLY – Email confirmation from AHN
- OPTION C ONLY – Email confirmation from Murdoch University Village
- OPTION D ONLY – Photocopy of caregiver's ID, which includes a photo and signature, such as a passport or driver's licence
- OPTION D ONLY – Evidence that the caregiver is eligible to remain in Australia until the student visa expires or student turns 18
- OPTION D ONLY – Photocopy of current Working with Children Checks, issued within the last 12 months, of the caregiver and any other adult living in the same household who are likely to interact with the student.

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SECTION 7: DECLARATION

I/We understand and accept the following:

- The welfare and accommodation arrangements approved on this document are until the student turns 18 years of age and cannot be changed without prior consent from MIT.
- Any alteration to the arrangements will require a new approval process, which includes the new documentation to be signed by the parent/guardian.
- MIT will only consider the changes to the agreed Welfare and Accommodation Agreement for the following reasons:
 - Failure on the part of the caregiver or accommodation provider to deliver the appropriate services to the student. This will be determined by MIT.
 - A parent, legal custodian or Department of Home Affairs approved guardian who arrives in Perth on a guardianship visa in order to resume the student's care arrangements.
- MIT may insist on changes to the care or accommodation arrangements due to the following circumstances:
 - The caregiver or accommodation provider fails to provide the appropriate services stipulated to the student.
 - Any form of dishonest or inappropriate behaviour by the caregiver or the accommodation provider.
- MIT will withdraw a student's Confirmation of Appropriate Accommodation and Welfare (CAAW) if the student does not maintain the arrangements agreed upon in this form. Cancellation of the CAAW may result in the cancellation of the student visa.
